

Request for Proposals (RFP) for Consolidation Feasibility Study

The Genoa Township Board of Trustees, Harlem Township Board of Trustees, and Delaware County Board of Commissioners is requesting proposals from professional consulting firms for a Fire/Rescue/EMS consolidation feasibility study. The following are issues and strategies to be addressed in the study.

- Feasibility of:
 - Creating one all encompassing emergency response service department providing fire protection, rescue services, EMS services, special response, along with fire and injury prevention, and education services
 - Creation of a fire district to include the geographical areas of Genoa Township and Harlem Township with County EMS maintained as independent service
 - Maintaining current services (status quo)
- Current and future facility needs over a ten (10) year period.
- Service delivery in regards to national standards
- Advantages of consolidation
- Disadvantages of consolidation
- Funding source(s) to sustain operations and future service delivery
- Organizational structure
- Manning
